## About PIMC

The Pacific International Music Competition was established in 2019. The competition is dedicated to promote classical music, to discover and support young musicians by providing them a professional learning platform, and to offer future performance engagement.

In the 2019-2020 PICM, over 20,000 NZD prize money was awarded. The Winner's Gala Concert was held in the Sydney Opera House in January 2020. The PICM committee is glad to see that many of the PIMC alumni are currently pursuing music performance degrees across the globe.

In the 2024-2025 Pacific International Music Competition (Online), there are three categories: Piano; Violin; and Lower Strings (Viola, Cello).

#### 1. Age Limit:

Age of competitor is to be taken as at 1st September 2024 in the year of the competition. Proof of age must be provided if requested.

2. Time limit: (No penalty for overtime, the adjudicator reserve the right to stop the overtime performance.)

11 year-old and under: 4 minuets

12 year-old and above: 5 minuets

Class by Grade:

No time limit

Piano Four Hand Class:

12 year-old and under: 4 minuets

13 year-old and above: 5 minuets

New Zealand Composition Class:

12 year-old and under: 4 minuets

13 year-old and above: 5 minuets

Concerto Class:

Own choice piece: 6 minuets.

No time limit for the concerto movement

# PIMC Winner's Concert in Sydney Opera House -

#### Utzon Room

The Sydney Opera House is one of the most iconic and distinctive buildings in the world, located on Bennelong Point in Sydney, Australia. Designed by Danish architect Jørn Utzon, it was completed in 1973 after a complex and extended construction period. The Opera House is renowned for its unique, sail-like design, which reflects its harbor setting and has made it a symbol of Sydney and Australia. It hosts a variety of performing arts events, including opera, theater, dance, and concerts, and is a UNESCO World Heritage Site, recognized for its architectural significance and innovative engineering.

The 2024-2025 Pacific International Music Competition Winner's Concert will be held at the Utzon Room at Sydney Opera House on *Monday April 28th*, 2025.
